Q1. Will the client accept non-Red Cross certification? Red Cross is a business in itself, and thus by requesting this business' certification, competition is limited to companies partnered with the Red Cross. As such it appears that other companies capable of teaching this curriculum will be eliminated from bidding.

A1. As per the Statement of Work, the Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) training must be that of the Canadian Red Cross with certification provided upon completion of the course.

Q2. What is the student/instructor ratio expected for classroom and practical portions of the course?

A2. The student/instructor ratio for this course is 1:12.

Q3. Will the client provide any vehicles necessary for training? Specifically, this client is a military organization with its own integral specialist vehicles. A portion of the training involves teach about moving injured personnel - will this be done using the unit's resources?

A3. The Contractor is responsible to provide all the associated support and training materials (Vehicles) required to conduct this course.
