The following changes, additions, and/or deletions are hereby made a part of the Solicitation Documents.

1. Request for Proposal

1. In the Request for Proposal, *DELETE* the following section:

SI06 TLICHO LAND CLAIMS AGREEMENT

The requirements of the Tlicho Land Claims and Self-Government Agreement (<http://www.ainc-inac.gc.ca/al/ldc/ccl/fagr/nwts/tliagr/tliagr-eng.pdf>) will apply to the proposed procurement. Bidders are therefore requested to maximize aboriginal employment, subcontracting and on-the-job training opportunities, and involve local, regional and Aboriginal citizens and businesses, in carrying out the work under this project. The benefits that apply to this procurement are contained in: Chapter 26, of the Tlicho Land Claims and Self-Government Agreement, clauses 26.3, 26.3.1 (a).

This area of the contract is within the Mōwhì Gogha Dè Nîîtâèè area, as defined in the Tlicho Land Claims and Self-Government Agreement, and proximate to Yellowknife and Akaitcho Dene First Nation.

- 6) Due to limited space, each company attending will be limited to one (1) representative for the Mandatory Site Visit and two (2) representatives for the Bidders Conference.

and *REPLACE* with:

SI05 MANDATORY SITE VISIT AND BIDDERS CONFERENCE

- 6) Each company can send two (2) representatives to the site visit; however, due to limited space and time only one (1) representative will be allowed to participate in the underground tour and both representatives can participate in the surface tour. Each company can send three (3) representatives to the Bidders Conference.

2. Responses to RFI's

Q: 1. Will the Contractor awarded the Interim Underground Stabilization contract be in a conflict of interest to bid and be successful on the Main Construction Management contract?

A: 1. Whoever is successful on the Interim Underground Design-Build contract will not be in conflict with being awarded the Main Construction Management contract.

Q: 2. This solicitation is complex and will require minimum two disciplines to see the site prior to recommendations to our corporate office to proceed.

a. We request two (2) individuals for the site visit and three for the Bidders conference

b. We request that the bidders conference be increased to three (3)

Please note that this requirement is not a request for additional information but a request to have the appropriate personnel view the site prior to proceeding with a 20-30 million dollar venture.

A: 2.a. Please refer to item 1.2 above. There will also be an additional optional site visit for further touring of the underground sites.

A: 2.b. Please refer to item 1.2 above.

The reference to this being "a 20-30 million dollar venture" is a projection put forward by this potential bidder and only included to provide full disclosure of the question as asked during the tender period.
