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This amendment 001 is to answer questions.

**Question 1.** What is the largest single map size that they would produce? The reason I ask is because the width dimension you are requesting is 60" minimum and I need to know if that's because of the need for ganging when printing (multiple maps on a single web) or do you actually have maps that are 60"x60" on a single sheet?

**Answer 1.** we aren't requesting a printing media that is in web format; single or multiple sheet only) 50 inch map is our largest. However there are products we produce that require a 60 inch sheet. The RFI does not mention that the 60" is the minimum, it states "... able to print... up to a size of 60 inches.

**Question 2.** I noticed on page 4;Section 2 a. there is mention of two-sided printing. How much two-sided printing is actually done? Is this an absolute "requirement".

**Answer 2.** Yes, it is a mandatory requirement. Our training area maps are printed on both sides. That being said, we are only looking for a press that prints on one side, when it dries the press operator flips the map and prints on the other side.

**Question 3.** On page 4;Section 2.g. you mention minimum thicknesses for substrates. Could you indicate the maximum thickness you will ever print on as well.

**Answer 3.** Must be capable of handling all types of media such as coated/uncoated paper, map bond paper, boards, vinyl, etc. with a minimum thickness of 0.10mm/0.004 inches up to 25.4mm/1 inch. Anything greater than 25.4mm/1 inch will also be considered.
