

This RFRE amendment 011 is raised to:

- Answer Question 31 and 32; and
 - Amend the RFRE Document.

Q31. Question

We would really encourage the Government expanding the number of persons per Respondent that can have access to the data room. The idea of having to continuously request persons to get on or off the list presents an administrative headache that in our opinion doesn't really enhance the security of the Data Room. If the Respondent and its personnel are cleared, and they have a need to be in the room (are working on the proposal), they should be allowed continued access. The challenge with the present set up is that there will be many disciplines that may need to get access to understand or work on some specific issues, while the core team requires access continually. Appreciate your consideration.

A31 Answer

Canada agrees to increase the maximum number of personnel per Qualified Respondent that will be granted access to the protected data room conditional upon satisfaction of the security requirements described in clause 6.1 of the RFRE at any given time to 50, see amendment below.

Q32. Question

I would ask that the access to the Unprotected Data Room be expanded to include those also in the Protected Data Room.

A32. Answer

Canada agrees to grant personnel of the Qualified Respondent who have been granted access to the Protected Data Room access to the unprotected data room. In conjunction with answer 31 this will effectively set the number of usernames per Qualified Respondent to 50.

At Annex E of the RFRE: Requirements for Access to Data Rooms (Government Furnished Information (GFI))

Delete Clause 1.6 in its entirety and replace with:

1.6. The maximum number of personnel per Qualified Respondent that will be granted access to the protected data room at any given time is 50. If an electronic username is used, each username is for the use of one individual, who is identified as the user by name and email address. Usernames must not be shared.

Delete Clause 1.10 in its entirety and replace with:

1.10. The protected data room will remain open to Qualified Respondents who are and remain eligible to participate in the RFP Stage of the procurement process until the close of the RFP Stage. Personnel per Qualified Respondent with access to the Protected Data Room will additionally be granted access to the Unprotected Data Room
