Q34. Question

Clause 6.2 of the RFRE sets out the National Security Requirements for the Respondent. An 'Other Team Member' could therefore be considered by definition a 'Team Member', although not part of the Joint Venture or SPV. In other words, please clarify if and why a proposed key subcontractor who is not proposed to be a shareholder in the Respondent's/Preferred Bidder's SPV, and will not control the SPV or be involved in the control of the SPV/Preferred Bidder, is required to satisfy all of the national security "control" requirements in clause 6.2?

Please consider modifying the requirements of 6.2.3, to change the requirement from 'Team Members' to 'Prime Team Members' only, as 'Other Team Members' are not in the position to control or influence decisions of the Joint Venture or SPV in any way shape or form.

A34. Answer

Clause 6.2 (National Security Requirements) of the RFRE is applicable to Other Team Members (which includes any Other Team Member that will be a key subcontractor of the SOC). Other Team Members are subject to the National Security Requirements described in Clause 6.2 of the RFRE because, as Other Team Members, they will have access to highly sensitive information and assets of Canada and AECL. Canada will not modify the requirements of clause 6.2.3 of the RFRE.
