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**Amendment no. 2 is raised to provide the following questions and answers and to provide the following changes.**

**Q1.** Can you please provide us with the breathability and moisture vapour permeability test method and required results for the waterproof/breathable material.

**A1.** Proponents are to provide written explanation of how their suits have breathability and prevent moisture. There is no test method that will be conducted for waterproof/breathable material.

**Q2.** Reinforcement of ballistic nylon. If as a separate layer at which areas of the suit.

**A2.** Please refer to item 7 of Annex B for location.

**Q3.** In the suit specification you refer to a patented neck seal method, if this is incorrect can you please restate the neck seal requirements?

**A3.** Agreed, neck seal requirement as follows: the neck seal is to provide a barrier from water egress into the drysuit which will keep the user comfortable

**Q4.** I suggest: ANNEX "B" SPECIFICATION 2: Is quickly venting more preferred than quickly closing? Is there an example of system that is preferred?

**A4.** Quickly venting is mandatory. There is no example or sample of system that is preferred. Vendor is to provide written explanation of how their product vents.

**Q5.** ANNEX "B" SPECIFICATION 4: Which type of repairs are expected to be encountered?

**A5.** Minor repairs (small cuts approximately 5 cm and pin holes)

**Q6.** ANNEX "B" SPECIFICATION 6 Thigh pockets- type and quantity of magazines expected. Types of lights and tools?

**A6.** A pocket size of 6 inches x 6 inches is desired - one 9 mm magazine. Unable to provide quantity because it could reveal the operational capabilities of a user. Lights that could be carried depending of user are mag lights (2 - 3 AA size, Surfire 2 cell type) Tools - compact pen knife, Leatherman and or other tools of users choice.

**Q7.** ANNEX "B" SPECIFICATION 10: Does this refer to footwear (ie boots) or a covering solution that is separate or attached either permanently or temporarily? If boots to be included in tender please provide preferred specifications.

**A7.** This is a covering solution that is attached ie: permanently attached booties which will enable the end user to have on heavy wool socks. Booties size would be determined at time of any resulting order.
