Question 1:

In three places in the RFP it is stated that "The Contractor's personnel must, at all time during the performance of the contract, maintain a valid RELIABILITY STATUS" However, it is also a mandatory requirement to have the status at the time of the bid. Due to summer holidays there are significant delays at CISD with processing the low level clearances required for this specific RFP. If the timelines cannot be met by CISD, would PWGSC consider accepting the proposed resources as long as the clearances are being processed by the bid closing and issued prior to the signing of the contract?

Answer 1:

Due to security considerations, the mandatory requirement to have a Reliability Status both at the time of the bid and during the performance of the contract remains the same.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
