Question:

Can you please indicate the amount of Rock Ex that is to be done in the actual project. I understand that there's 750 Cu m outside of the project. We are looking to see if there's any rock needed to be drill/blast inside the project working area.

Answer:

"The Rock Removal quantity is an allowance based on the geotechnical boreholes that were complete and the work (Storm and Sanitary Sewer, Light Standard bases etc.) that that may require rock removal. This is a unit rate item and will be measure based on actual rock removed. Note that blasting is not permitted and rock is to be removed by mechanical mean only."

Question:

In regards to the asbestos pipe on this project, I want to ensure that any removal of asbestos pipe will be dealt with as an extra. If contractors are to include this removal in our pricing we need more information on the existing pipe. What size is it? Is it friable or non-friable asbestos? What is the type of material? Please clarify.
