ADDENDUM NO. 5

Further to the above mentioned Request for Proposal documentation previously posted on the Government Electronic Tendering Site (GETS) Addendum (#5) is hereby issued.

Question 1:

Is it a mandatory requirement to be aligned with ICS Canada as stated in RFP Appendix C.

Answer 1:

There is no specific mandatory requirement to be "aligned" with ICS Canada. However, in order to meet the Mandatory Requirement, M1 – Understanding the Objective, as outlined in Appendix D, there is a need to "satisfy the requirements under section 3 - Scope of Work of the related Statement of Work." In particular (amongst other things), the selected bidder's resources must:

- Validate ICS Canada's ICS-200 training curriculum in consultation with CCG subject matter experts;
- Collaborate with ICS Canada to receive endorsement of tailored scenarios for use during training delivery; and
- Be consistent with ICS Canada's Incident Command System Student, Training and Training Provider Standards document and deliver ICS-200 training.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
