Questions and Answers 4 & 5

Please see questions 4 & 5 below, posed by a potential bidder, and their accompanying responses.

Q4: Our company is preparing a proposal for this bid, however, to provide you with the best and most accurate information would it be possible to have the closing date extended beyond August 5th?

A4: Yes, the closing date will be extended to Wednesday, August 13, 2014.

Q5: In reviewing the above noted RFP, I noticed that in section 3.1 it indicates that all personnel shall hold a security screening at the level of enhanced Reliability Status <u>upon contract award</u> and at all times during performance of work under the contract. However, in the Mandatory requirements section MT3, the fourth point states that Drivers must have the security clearance at <u>bid submission</u>. Could you please clarify if the security clearance is required at bid submission or by contract award date.

A5: All personnel are required to have a valid enhanced reliability security clearance by bid submission.
