This amendment is raised for the MRR Request For Proposal (RFP) number W8476-133817/E.

The intent of this amendment is to provide a clarifying response to Industry poised questions and where applicable, amend the RFP in response to Industry questions.

Questions and Answers No. 105 to 110.

Q105. Reference: Annex A-ACQ SOW, Section 4.5.2; “The first article test shall be based on the Requirements Traceability and Verification Matrix (RTVM) at Appendix 5”. Furthermore, the RTVM identified approximately 35 different requirements to be tested in First Article Testing that will require live fire testing.

- a) Can you confirm that the Crown will provide the test range, ammunition, effectors, and all personnel required to operate the range and effectors for these tests?
- b) Also in the RTVM, Production Article testing is identified for 6 cases requiring live fire to execute. Will the Crown provide the test range, ammunition, effectors, and all personnel required to operate the range and effectors for these tests as well?

A105.

- a) **Per 4.6.2 of Annex A-ACQ SOW** Canada will NOT provide the test range, ammunition, effectors and personnel required to operate the range and effectors for the tests referenced in Annex A-ACQ SOW Section 4.5.2.
- b) **Per 4.6.2 of Annex A-ACQ SOW** Canada will NOT provide the test range and effectors for the tests referenced in the RTVM, Production Article Testing.

Q106. Reference: In the Contract, Part 7 – Resulting Contract Clauses – MRR Acquisition Contract, paragraph 1.1 states “All MRR systems, STTE and Spares must be delivered to 7 CFSD Edmonton, Alberta. However, Part 8 – Resulting Contract Clauses – In-Service Support Contract, paragraph 1.1.a.i states “... dedicated FSRs shall be provided at 4 AD Regt, CFB Gagetown, New Brunswick, Canada.” In addition, in the ACQ SOW, page 17, paragraph 5.10.9 states “The Contractor shall conduct training at Canadian Armed Forces Base Gagetown, New Brunswick, Canada and the ISS SOW, page 7, paragraph 1.5.1 states “The MRR Systems will be in service with the 4th Air Defence Regiment, RCA, located at CFB Gagetown, NB.”

Can we assume the Crown will transport the systems from Edmonton to Gagetown where the training must be conducted within 6 weeks of delivery of the first system per ACQ SOW paragraph 5.10.7.b

A106. DND will transport the systems from the delivery point to the training area.

Q107. Reference: Annex K – Appendix 6, section 2.2.3; “The System under test shall be required to locate these weapons to the required desirable accuracy for 80% of the shots fired.”

Does the reference to 80% of shots fired meeting desirable location accuracy mean that 20% of the shots fired can be discarded with regards to calculating the location accuracy CEP for Live Fire Evaluation purposes?

A107. Section 2.2.3; “The System under test shall be required to locate these weapons to the required desirable accuracy for 80% of the shots fired.” which is taken to mean an 80% Probability of valid Location of the shot.”

Q108. Reference: Annex K – Appendix 6, Section 5.1.3; “Desirable Requirement 14 - The bidder must demonstrate through air surveillance the capability to detect and track a 1 meter² target at ranges from 75km to 125 km demonstrating the desirable range performance of the System.” Annex K – Appendix 6, Section 5.1.4; “Desirable Requirement 15 - The bidder must demonstrate through air surveillance the capability to detect and track a 0.1 meter² target at ranges from 25km to 40 km demonstrating the desirable range performance of the System.”

Does the 1 km minimum range requirement need to be evaluated for Desirable Requirements 14 & 15?

A108. The 1km minimum range and the Desirable Requirement 14 & 15 have to be demonstrated in the same system configuration using the same Radar mode.
