Her Majesty reserves the right to modify the Listing Agreement and should negotiations fail, if any, Her Majesty reserves the right not to contract at all.

3. **Question:** The documents I have downloaded all have draft written on them. Is there a place to access truly blank documents to fill out? Perhaps there is a site where these documents can be filled out on line, too.

Answer: The Draft Contract is a draft of the contract that the Proponent is expected to execute. It cannot be altered and is not subject to negotiation.

4. **Question:** We are interested in bidding on the solicitations listed above, please advise if we able to see these properties at another time. And/or under what conditions we would be allowed to bid given we have not been to the site.

Answer: The site visit is a mandatory requirement of the RFP. An alternative date will not be provided should a Proponent miss the scheduled site visit.
