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**QUESTION:**

Confirm that a completed insurance form is not required with the Bid. Amendment 001 deleted the original invitation to tender which confirmed that it did not have to be submitted.

**RESPONSE:**

Bid as per Invitation to Tender documents. Refer to Supplementary Conditions SC02 item 3.

**QUESTION:**

What is the duration of the maintenance period after completion, if any?

**RESPONSE:**

Bid as per plans and specifications. Refer to section 01 78 00 – Closeout Submittals, item 1.11 for warranties and bonds. Also bid as per Invitation to Tender documents. Refer to Contract Documents (CD) item 1 d.

**QUESTION:**

Is there a maintenance holdback?

**RESPONSE:**

Bid as per Invitation to Tender documents. Refer to Contract Documents (CD) item 1 d.

**QUESTION:**

Are there liquidated damages if construction goes beyond 104 weeks?

**RESPONSE:**

Bid as per Invitation to Tender documents. Refer to Contract Documents (CD) item 1 d.

**QUESTION:**

Section 01 35 43, Page 10, 4<sup>th</sup> from bottom – States to minimize blasting and truck traffic between March and July however, page 14, second from bottom – states to suspend blasting and other heavy truck traffic between May 9 and July 31. Which applies? Page 14 would virtually bring production to a halt for nearly 2 months. Please elaborate on this requirement. What is it trying to achieve? What is your definition of heavy truck? What areas must be avoided by trucks?

**QUESTION:**

How will the amounts of the progress draws be determined since most of the work is in a Lump Sum in the form of tender? Is the payment schedule to be negotiated with the successful bidder?

**RESPONSE:**

**QUESTION:**

It is very important to submit the response to the second question to all the contractors. Because you are effectively doubling the price of grouting since it must be included in the lump sum and it is already fully covered by the unit pricing.

**QUESTION:**

For what's in question 1, you do not respond to the question. Do we have to construct cofferdams to complete the demolition of the dams in the dry? Yes or no.

**ADDENDUM No. 5**  
**PROJECT No. R.052598.506**

**The following changes in the bid documents are effective immediately. This addendum will form part of the contract documents.**

**Specification**

1. Section 31 32 23, Part 1.1 Unit Prices
  - a. Delete clause .1
  - b. Replace with clause .1 – Total grouting to be priced as per unit price table in the Bid and Acceptance Form. Any additional amounts beyond the quantities shown will be paid based on the actual quantities measured on site and subject to written authorization from the Departmental Representative.
2. Section 02 41 16, Part 3.2 DEMOLITION
  - a. Delete clause .9
  - b. Replace with clause .9 - Once the new dams are commissioned and the roadway is linked, the existing dams will be completely demolished and removed. Complete demolition means demolition of the entire structures. This will require the use of additional dewatering to ensure complete demolition is achieved.
