ANNEX A - STATEMENT OF WORK

3.1. Overview

3.1.2. The Contractor must deliver the CEMD meeting all the performance requirements detailed in Annex C - Mandatory Specifications for the CEMD. A unit of CEMD consists of following elements:

Delete:

- (g) Operator / Repair / Procedural Manual with Parts List.

Insert:

- (g) Operator Manual and Quick Reference Guide

All other terms and conditions of the RFP remain unchanged.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q.1 On page 31, DND stated that the detector must be delivered with “operator / repair / procedural manual with parts lists”. We interpret this as one operator manual, one repair (maintenance) manual and one parts list with every detector.

On page 100 to 103, CDRL CEMD ILS-206, ILS-207 and ILS-208 state that DND want 1 quick reference guide and 1 operator manual for every detector and only 3 maintenance manual.

Which one is correct?

A.1 DND don't need Repair (maintenance) Manual with every detector. The CDRLs CEMD ILS-206, ILS-207 and ILS-208 on pages 100 to 103 are correct. Para 3.1.2 (g) one page 31 must be corrected to state: One Operator Manual and Quick Reference Guide.

Q.2 Reference Annex A-2 integrated Logistic Support (ILS) para 1.1.2.7 - Identification Plates: “the contractor must ensure that all CEMD associated components have those identification plates or markings IAW Section 10.1 of DID CEMD-ILS-204 prior to being delivered to DND” - Can the Corwn identify further the expected number of ID Plates required for each CEMD? The CEMD consist of the following: the detector (serialize nameplate), the battery set, the headset, the hard transport case, the soft carry case. Please confirm which components require an Identification Plate.

A.2 The CF Standard for Identification Plate of Canadian Property states that the items affected are major assemblies such as units, sets and other items directed by DND must have marking. The contents of Identification Plates use in the contract must be without Military Nomenclature and used the table at page 3-2-10 of the standard D-02-002-001/SG-001.

The following components require an Identification Plats:

Detector (serialize nameplate): Yes with serial number

Battery Set: only if it is a battery pack is explicit to the detector, COTS alkaline batteries do not need Identification Plates.

Headset: yes

Hard Transport Cae: Yes

Soft Carry Case: not necessary

If the assembly has removable cable, the cable needs to have Identification Plates as per Figure 3-2-5 at page 3-2-12 of the standard D-02-002-001/SG-001 and attached to the cable using transparent heat shrink tubing.
