Further to the above mentioned Request for Proposal documentation previously posted on the Government Electronic Tendering Site (GETS) Addendum (#3) is hereby issued.

Question 1)

We understand that the Department of Fisheries has been obtaining their IMIM Training (Use of Force Model) from the RCMP depot in Regina for many years now.

Answer 1)

The training conducted at the RCMP Depot in Regina is only for Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) Fisheries Officers. Participants in the LEFT course are CCG employees are and are not Peace Officers.

Question 2)

In the request, the description of the training suggests the IMIM model for Use of Force, but the National Use of Force Framework is based on the training that is done at the Ontario Police College, so two different models. We are confused as to what you are looking for: the IMIM model that is trademarked with the RCMP or the National Use of Force model used by law enforcement agencies other than the RCMP?

Answer 2)

For the purposes of the LEFT course, the CCG considers the RCMP IMIM and the Canadian Association of Chiefs of Police National Use of the Force Framework to be equivalent.

Question 3)

Does your use of force policy stipulate the use of the RCMP IMIM or could the National Use of Force Framework be an option?

Answer 3)

The Department Use of Force and Officer Safety Policy applies to Fisheries Officers who are engaged in active enforcement operations and, as such, does not apply to participants in the LEFT course.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
