**Amendment 008**

The objective of amendment 008 is to provide bidders with questions/answers 49 to 51.

Included in this solicitation amendment:

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**1. Questions and answers**

**Question 49)**

In the technical specifications, section 35 20 23, article 3.11 *ADDITIONAL DREDGING*:

*.1 Following the environmental characterization of the dredging polygons in which the final acceptance sounding confirms that the basic work and/or optional work have been completed, complete any additional dredging in the zones identified by the Departmental Representative at its request.*

Do clauses determining the decision for additional dredging are the same as the clauses determining the optional work? If not, what is the maximum time limit for decision making to request additional dredging work?

**Answer 49)**

The decision-making process for the additional dredging work differs from that of optional work. In the case of additional dredging, required or optional, Canada will proceed in a phased approach to the environmental characterization of the dredging polygons declared completed upon acceptance of dredging work (article 3.9, section 35 20 23 of the technical specifications. Thus, the decision of whether to make or not additional dredging in some areas will generally be communicated to the contractor before the end of his dredging program. Where appropriate, Canada will pay the Contractor the waiting time caused by delay in identifying areas that should undergo additional dredging, according to the unit price established in article 2.5 of the Unit Price table. The Contractor shall complete, if applicable, the additional dredging for the required work, preceding any optional dredging work.

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**Question 50)**

In Article 3.4.18.2 of section 35 20 23, it is indicated: *"If release of hydrocarbons from the sediment creates a film on the water surface, plan for containment of the zone where the dredging is taking place with double booms or absorbent pads or other method sufficient to contain and recover the film of hydrocarbons in the work zone"*

Referring to the previous article (3.4.18.1 Section 35 20 23), is this requirement applies only to the dredging Polygon A?

**Answer 50)**

No, the Contractor shall confine any resurgence of oil, whatever its origin, using oil booms lined with absorbent socks or other sufficiently effective method to contain and recover the oil film in the area work, with no regard to a dredging Polygon or a dredged area. In addition, the Contractor shall also confine within the work area, recover immediately and remove without additional cost to Canada any material rising to the water surface in the harbor of Gaspé because of his work, without regard to a dredging
