This amendment is created to answer questions from bidders:

Question:

With regards to the stated requirement #3g and #9 in the Statement of Work for a capacity of 4500 sheets in the output tray, we would request that this requirement be lowered to 3000 sheets to increase competition and reduce cost. The current requirement equates to 4500 simplex or 9000 duplex impressions; this translates to slightly more than two hours (128 minutes) of duplex printing. Assuming that you have different paper loaded in each of the 4 trays, the most number of sheets you would print on before you had to stop would be 2500 which is the minimum size of the mandatory high capacity tray. Secondly, given the evaluated volume is averaging 50,000 colour prints per month, this equates to an average daily volume of 2,380 sheets over a 21 day period. This would mean a 3,000 sheet capacity tray would only need to be emptied once per day to accommodate your average simplex prints or once every second day for duplex prints. To reduce the cost and increase competition into the RFP process, a 3000 sheet exit tray should provide ample capacity for your current workload.

Answer:

With respect to the need of a 4500 sheets output tray, we understand that by taking a monthly average then dividing it on a daily basis leaves a very tangible workload which could easily be taken care of with a smaller stacker. But in reality averaging does not paint a true picture. We, like every other printing firm, go through peaks and valleys; we can easily get months where we have very little colour and others where we can print up to 200K impressions a month. With the upcoming Census the latter is very feasible.

All other terms and conditions of the RFP remain unchanged.
