SECTION A - QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q54. Can you please tell us whether Canada has a Project Labor Agreement on the Port Granby LTWMF project? In other words, are there union labor requirements on this project?

A54. There are no union labour requirements for the Port Granby LTWMF Project.

Q55. Project Labor Agreements

In order to prepare a complete bid package for the Port Granby LTWMF project, we need to determine the "organized labor" status of the site (whether unionized or not). Please clarify if there are existing project labor agreements in place to support the LTWMF project.

A55. There are no union labour requirements for the Port Granby LTWMF Project.

Q56. The Contract Documents are identified on page 28 and include under item d) General Conditions and clauses: GC6 Delays and Changes in the Work: R2860D (2013-04-25). SC23 (p. 24) includes modifications to R2865D which is an alternate to R2860D. Is the intent to incorporate R2860D or R2865D?

A56. The intent is to incorporate R2865D.

Q57. Appendix 5, Section 3.1.2: May the project schedule be excluded from the sixty (60) page limit? If not, may we use a smaller font than 11 pt for the schedule?

A57. No. The schedule must be presented in compliance with the RFP requirements and within the allotted total pages.

Q58. Does a former employee of a Conflicted Consulting Company, AECL or PHAI now working for a Bidder have any exclusions from the Bidders Bid Team?

A58. Whether an individual would be in a conflict of interest position would depend on his/her personal involvement in the preparation of that solicitation and not necessarily that of the company for which he/she worked. The factors that determine whether a bidder or individual is in position of a conflict of interest can be found in R2710T - GI17, Conflict of Interest - Unfair Advantage.

Q59. When is the anticipated award date of this contract?

A59. The anticipated award date is Spring 2015.

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SECTION B - MODIFICATIONS TO THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

A number of questions have been raised on security clearance.

In light of a number of questions raised on security clearance, we are taking the opportunity to address these questions through a single response and to advise bidders of a significant change in the security requirements. After careful review and consideration, a Designated Organization Screening (DOS) will no longer be required. A Request for Private Sector Organization Screening (PSOS) will therefore not be required. Bidders will not need to meet security requirements at the time of bid closing or at the time of contract award; **however**, once the contract has been awarded and before work commences, the Contractor's personnel requiring access to sensitive work site(s) must hold a valid RELIABILITY STATUS, granted or approved either by AECL/CNL or CISD/PWGSC.

AECL will handle all personnel security screening after contract award and the CISD no longer needs to be involved; however, AECL will accept valid certificates of clearance issued by CISD.

Please refer to the modifications to the Request for Proposal.

DELETE: SI13 in its entirety and replace with the following:

SI13 SECURITY RELATED REQUIREMENTS

The successful Bidder's personnel, as well as any subcontractor and its personnel, who are required to perform any part of the work pursuant to the subsequent Contract must meet the mandatory security requirement as indicated in section SC01 of the Supplementary Conditions to the General Conditions.

Individuals who do not have the required level of security will not be allowed on site. It is the responsibility of the successful bidder to ensure that the security requirements are met throughout the performance of the Contract. Neither the Contracting Party nor the Contract Counterparty (as defined in SI19) will be held liable or accountable for any delays or additional costs associated with the successful bidder's non-compliance with the mandatory security requirement.

DELETE SC01 in its entirety and replace with the following:

SC01 SECURITY REQUIREMENTS

The following security requirement (and related clauses) applies and form part of the Contract.

SECURITY REQUIREMENT FOR CANADIAN SUPPLIER:

AECL/CNL security policy, in conjunction with the Policy on Government Security states that all contract staff shall undergo a screening process if their job duties or tasks necessitate access to sensitive information and assets. Contractors are required to co-operate and assist AECL/CNL in their efforts to obtain the necessary clearance.

1. The Contractor's personnel requiring access to sensitive work site(s) must EACH hold a valid RELIABILITY STATUS, granted or approved either by AECL/CNL or CISD/PWGSC.

Until the security screening of the Contractor personnel required by this Contract has been completed satisfactorily by AECL/CNL or PWGSC, the Contractor personnel **may not enter sites without an escort.**

2. Subcontracts which contain security requirements are NOT to be awarded without the prior written permission of AECL/CNL.

3. **Reliability Status (RS)**

Upon contract award, the Contractor's personnel are required to co-operate and assist AECL/CNL in their efforts to obtain AECL/CNL Reliability Status and Site Access Clearance. **Security Clearance forms will be provided to the Contractor by the AECL/CNL Sponsor. Only after the documents for the Reliability Status and the Site Access forms have been received and determined to be completed correctly by the AECL/CNL Personnel Security Office will the process for security clearance begin.** The Contractor's personnel will be required to sign a consent form that gives AECL/CNL permission to conduct the security checks. Individuals who refuse to sign the consent form will not be permitted to work on restricted sites or have access to AECL/CNL information or assets.

The documents required for the Reliability Status and the Site Access forms can be faxed, emailed or delivered to the AECL/CNL Personnel Security Office (613-584-1670) **no less than two (2) weeks prior to commencement of work on the site.** If faxed, on the fax cover sheet the following information is required: Company Name, & phone number; name of contact person; and, the AECL/CNL Sponsor's name. If the forms are incomplete, and AECL/CNL Security Personnel are required to contact you for additional information, this could delay the start of work.

On or before their first day on site, the contractor's personnel are required to provide AECL/CNL Personnel Security with original or certified copies (must be certified by a Notary Public or in the case of transcripts, the Registrar seal) of the following documentation (**photocopies are NOT acceptable**):

- Birth certificate or Baptismal certificate or passport and Canadian Citizenship card (individuals born outside of Canada).
- Record of Landing or Employment Authorization if individual is not a Canadian citizen.
- Educational document (certificate, diploma or official transcript) for the highest level obtained.
- One reference letter to confirm employment history for the past 5 years.
- One personal character reference letter from an individual whom you have known for the past 5 years and not being a relative.

- **Canadian Criminal Record Check (Disclosure of Criminal Record Information):** This check is conducted by AECL/CNL Personnel Security Officers and the Contractor will require its personnel to cooperate in all reasonable manner to obtain such a record check. A Criminal Record Check is also required from every country where an individual has lived in the past 5 years. These can be obtained through the consulate or embassy of each country or may be available through a third party verification company.

If the required documentation is not provided on or before the first day of work, the individual will not be allowed to start work and will have to leave the site until all required documents have been provided to AECL/CNL Security.

4. **Site Access Clearance**

Reliability Status is the first step to receiving Site Access. To ensure the clearance is in effect before the Work in the Protected Area commences, the Contractor must submit to AECL/CNL the required documents **no less than two (2) weeks** prior to the commencement of work on the site. The Site Access forms will be provided by the AECL/CNL Sponsor at the time of Contract Award.

Please Note: Faxes or emails will be accepted to expedite the clearance process but **original documents, as detailed above, must be provided before you can be admitted to the site to work.**

5. **Individuals With Criminal Records**

Individuals having a criminal record will be subject to an interview and risk analysis to allow AECL/CNL Security to determine whether it can grant the required clearance.

6. **Public Works and Government Services Canada Clearance**

AECL/CNL will recognize Contractor's employees having Public Works and Government Services Canada clearance. Contractor employees having a clearance through Public Works and Government Services must present the certificate to AECL/CNL Security for verification. Individuals having a certificate will be requested to fill in a consent form to enable the AECL/CNL Personnel Security Officer to run a current criminal record name check.
