Request for Proposal

1. Question # 1:

As confirmed in the RFP you do not require proponents to submit a lump sum price for the services, however require proponents to provide two sets of hourly rates, QS and junior QS. Please confirm if there will be a minimum number of hours that will be requested per service at one time, for example 8 or 40, or if services can be requested per hour.

Answer:

Proponents are to determine the level of effort required per resources, based on past experience on similar complex projects, which have comparable values and durations.

2. Question # 2:

Please confirm how use of either a QS or Junior QS will be determined, as your RFP 4.1.5 confirms 'The Departmental Representative may specify which of the Resources (Senior or Junior Quantity Surveyor) is to be used for specific requirements of the work.

Answer:
