Question

I am looking to see what major road the Design, Fabrication and Installation of a 61m Guyed VHF Tower project is located close to?

Answer

The answer is either “Bay St. Lawrence Road” or “Cabot Trail”, depending on your definition of “major road”.

The specifications state that the site is accessed via 7.2 km of narrow gravel road. The gravel road begins at the Bay St. Lawrence Road, a paved provincial road that runs between Cape North and Bay St. Lawrence. The junction of the gravel road with the Bay St. Lawrence Road is labelled “A” on the linked Google map.

The only major highway in northern Cape Breton Island is the Cabot Trail. The Bay St. Lawrence Road connects to the Cabot Trail at Cape North, 13.4 km from where the gravel road begins. The junction of the Bay St. Lawrence Road with the Cabot Trail is labelled “B” on the linked Google map.
