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This addendum forms part of the tender documents and modifies them as here-in stated. The following sections of the Invitation to Tender, drawings and specifications have been modified.

**Question 1:** The bid documents require trade certification submission for each category listed. We do not have staff with all of these certificates. Will subcontractor trade certificates be required as part of this submission? Subcontractors could change over the course of the standing offer time frame.

**Answer 1:** Journeyman rates are required. Sub-contractor trade certificates can be provided. If a subcontractor changes during the course of the Standing Offer, the trade certifications must be provided to PWGSC & DND prior to any work being completed.

**Question 2:** Regarding Annex B, it states that all work will be paid on firm hourly rates. We do not have a glazier on staff, so if we submit an hourly rate, but our subcontractors rate rises over the course of the standing offer, we would have a shortfall. Can these situations be handled by having a subcontractor submit a quote to us and we add a markup and submit to DND? If so, can there be a line added under the Unit Price Schedules?

**Answer 2:** A rate must be entered for each item listed in the unit price schedule of the offer. The items listed on the unit price schedule can be completed by a sub-contractor, however the rate charged must be in accordance with the unit price schedule. A mark-up on the sub-contractor quote for items on the unit price schedule will not be accepted.

**Question 3:** Will the contracts be awarded on lowest price? Or will this be on a submission review basis?

**Answer 3:** Refer to per Part 4 – Evaluation Procedures and Basis of Selection of the RFSO.

**Question 4:** Regarding Page 19 Item 23.3.2 (time sheet sign off), it requires DND rep to sign off on time sheets at the end of each shift. This could be problematic, as reps are not always on site or easy to track down. Do time sheets need to be signed every day?

**Answer 4:** Time sheets will be required to be signed off by a contracts inspector every day. All contract inspectors carry cell phones, in the event that a trade needs to leave early.
