1.5 Certifications Required Precedent to Contract Award

Canada will declare a bid non-responsive, or will declare a contractor in default in carrying out any of its obligations under the Contract, if any certification made by the Bidder is found to be untrue, whether made knowingly or unknowingly, during the bid evaluation period or during the contract period.

The Contracting Authority will have the right to ask for additional information to verify the Bidder's certifications. Failure to comply with any request or requirement imposed by the Contracting Authority may render the bid non-responsive or constitute a default under the Contract.

1.5.1 Integrity Provisions - Associated Information

By submitting a bid, the Bidder certifies that the Bidder and its Affiliates are in compliance with the provisions as stated in Section 01 Integrity Provisions - Bid of Standard Instructions [2003 \(2014-09-25\)](#). The associated information required within the Integrity Provisions will assist Canada in confirming that the certifications are true.

1.6 Enquiries - Bid Solicitation

1.7 Evaluation Procedures

1.7.1 Technical Evaluation

All bids must be completed in full and provide all of the information requested in the bid solicitation to enable full and complete evaluation.

1.7.1.1 Mandatory Technical Criteria

Must be compatible with existing DSX5000 test sets.

1.7.2 Financial Evaluation

1.7.1.2.1 Pricing Basis

The bidder must quote firm unit in Canadian dollars, DDP Delivered Duty Paid at the destination of page one (1) of this solicitation, Applicable Taxes extra, as applicable. Freight charges to destination and all applicable Custom duties and Excise taxes must be included.

1.7.3. Basis of Selection

A bid must comply with the requirements of the bid solicitation and meet all mandatory technical evaluation criteria to be declared responsive. The responsive bid with the lowest evaluated price will be recommended for award of a contract.
