1. Purpose and Nature of the Request for Information (RFI)

Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC) is requesting Industry feedback regarding A possible product/solution for File and Folder Encryption solution for the endpoint protection of IM/IT security for the Department of National Defence (DND) / Canadian Armed Forces (CAF).

The objective of this RFI is to solicit information on the availability of a product or solution capable of meeting DNDs needs.

This RFI is neither a call for tender nor a Request for Proposal (RFP). No agreement or contract will be entered into based on this RFI. The issuance of this RFI is not to be considered in any way a commitment by the Government of Canada, nor as authority to potential respondents to undertake any work that could be charged to Canada. This RFI is not to be considered as a commitment to issue a subsequent solicitation or award contract(s) for the work described herein.

Although the information collected may be provided as commercial-in-confidence (and, if identified as such, will be treated accordingly by Canada), Canada may use the information to assist in drafting performance specifications (which are subject to change) and for budgetary purposes.

Respondents are encouraged to identify, in the information they share with Canada, any information that they feel is proprietary, third party or personal information. PWGSC is seeking information from the Industry with respect to possible product/solution for File and Folder Encryption solution for the endpoint protection of IM/IT security for the Department of National Defence (DND)/ Canadian Armed Forces (CAF).

On June 11, 2014, Entrust announced the end-of-support and end-of life dates for Entrust Group Share. Customers like DND with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Entrust until June 16, 2015.

DND is looking of a File and Folder Encryption solution which provides an enterprise level encryption client capable of enabling client workgroup collaboration and supporting centralized management and administration. DND needs to provide a solution that meets requirements for host-based encryption and collaboration.

Objectives of the RFI include:

1. Confirm availability of products or solutions for implementing File and Folder Encryption technology.
2. Receive responses from the vendor community about available solutions, new techniques and technologies concerning File and Folder Encryption.
3. Vendors who establish via their response to the RFI how their product(s)/solution(s) meet the detailed solution requirements may be invited to provide an interactive demonstration and discuss in detail how their product(s)/solution(s) meet the listed requirements.

File and Folder Encryption Management Requirements:
