The viewing sample shall be returned to the RCMP in the same condition as received by the manufacturer. Lost or damaged viewing samples shall be replaced by an identical item or the RCMP shall be reimbursed for the cost of an acceptable replacement.

PURCHASE DESCRIPTION

NAME TAG, EMBROIDERED

1. **SCOPE**

This purchase description describes the requirements for a "Name Tag, Embroidered" for use by Royal Canadian Mounted Police personnel.

2. **DETAILED DESCRIPTION**

- 2.1 <u>Base Fabric</u> Cloth, 70% Wool, 30% Polyester, Twill, colour navy blue, as per RCMP specification 'G.S.1045-115, Cloth, Wool, Polyester', with pellon or equivalent backing. The twill direction shall be right to left. **Shall be purchased from the RCMP**.
- 2.2 Embroidery Thread Viscose rayon, Schiffli twist, bright finish, linear density 99 dtex/2 to 135 dtex/2. Polyester thread may be used. Colour shall be Pantone Cool Grey 11C. Madeira No. 40 polyneon, dtex 135/2, colour #1640 is known to meet the above requirements.

A certificate of compliance must be provided.

2.3 <u>Merrow Edge</u> - Viscose rayon or polyester, linear density 600dtex/2 may be used. Colour shall be dark navy blue and must match the base fabric colour. Pantone colour 532C shall be used a colour match reference.

A certificate of compliance must be provided.

2.4 <u>Hook Fastener</u> – Woven nylon with an 8.0mil monofilament hook. When used in conjunction with Velcro no. 1000 loop tape (or other equivalents), shall have the following characteristics: 8p.s.i. length-wise shear strength, with an initial peel strength of 1 p.i.w. and after 1000 cycles shall be not less than 0.5 p.i.w. with a minimum lengthwise shear strength of 4 p.s.i.

A certificate of compliance must be provided.

2.5 <u>Letter Font and Size</u> - Font to be Arial, as per attached drawing. A close approximation of the size is 32pt, letters in Bold, provided the requirements for letter size as shown in the attached drawing are met. Up to fourteen (14) letters and spaces may be accommodated on the name tag by using the lettering font as detailed. A condensed width version of the same font may be used to provide up to eighteen (18) letters and spaces for names that exceed fourteen letters or will not fit using the regular font. If necessary, a smaller font size in regular or condensed version may be used to

accommodate names that cannot be embroidered successfully using the full size condensed font.

<u>Note</u>: Other lettering, such as Canadian Aboriginal Syllabics, may be used in place of the Latin alphabet as and when required, when approved by the RCMP.
