QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. Annex C" Evaluation and Basis of Selection"

Evaluation of Compliance to Mandatory Requirements: Each Offer will be reviewed for compliance with the mandatory requirements of the solicitation. All elements of the solicitation that are mandatory requirements are identified specifically with the words "must" or "mandatory". Offers that do not comply with each and every mandatory requirement will be considered non-responsive and be disqualified.

Criteria "M1" states: The Offeror must demonstrate that they met all requirements as described in this RFSO.

The above evaluation criteria are quite a vague and we are looking to clarify what specifically we require in our response to be compliant to the PWGSC's requirement. Do we need to respond to each and every clause in the entire RFSO document? Or are you looking for responses to Annex C where mandatory criteria are listed ("M1" to M6")?

- A1. Offerors must meet all of the mandatory requirements as described within this RFSO. All consumables offered must meet the mandatory requirements described in Annex A – Requirement and Annex C - Evaluation and Basis of Selection. If Offerors fail to meet the minimum percentage of consumables as described in Annex C and fails to meet the mandatory criteria described within the RFSO, it will be considered non-responsive, and it will not be evaluated further.
- Q2.** When reviewing the format of the document, the Technical offer is clearly laid out on page 8 of 54 with points a, b and c. However, later in the document, Annex C "Evaluation and Basis of Selection" requests additional content listed as Mandatory Criteria "M1" – "M6". Are we to include responses to these requirements with the Technical proposal?
- A2. Offerors are required to response to all mandatory criteria listed in Annex C and the technical offer with points a and b.
- Q3.** Our intention is to purchase remanufactured consumables from a CGSB certified remanufacturer to supply that portion of the bid. Do we simply state that fact in our response along with the appropriate certification information for the remanufacturer or is there another process?
- A3. The Offerors can simply state that fact along with appropriate certification information.
- Q4.** What steps if any have been taken to insure an individual company does not submit multiple bid disguised as separate companies by way of incorporating and or registering different names which in essence are one organization?
- A4. In 2006 (2014-09-25) Standard Instructions – Request for Standing Offers – Goods or Services – Competitive Requirements, Section 12 Rejection of Offer:

3. Canada reserves the right to apply additional scrutiny, in particular, when multiple offers are received in response to a request for standing offers from a single offeror or a joint venture. Canada reserves the right to:
- i. reject any or all of the offers submitted by a single offeror or joint venture if their inclusion in the evaluation has the effect of prejudicing the integrity and fairness of the process, or;
 - ii. reject any or all of the offers submitted by a single offeror or joint venture if their inclusion in the procurement process would distort the solicitation evaluation, and would cause a result that would not reasonably have been expected under prevailing market conditions and/or would not provide good value to Canada.

Q5. Can Canada allow bidders to submit their bids to either Vancouver or to the bid receiving unit at Promenade du Portage in Hull (Ottawa)?

A5. Offers must be submitted only to PWGSC Bid Receiving Unit by the date, time and place (Vancouver) indicated on page 1 of the Request for Standing Offers.
