Scope of Work/Key Activities:

Industry Canada has the need for an Application Software Architect level 3 to assist the CIPO IT Implementation of Bills C-31 and C-8 for Trade-Marks project team providing expertise in JAVA architecture, analysis, design, development, implementation and support. This resource will be required to define, plan, develop large scale application and component architectures in a diverse, distributed technical environment. Their duties will include but not be limited to the following:

- Assess the impact that changes in the technical architecture may have on business operations and procedures including systems maintenance and support and telecommunications infrastructure;
- Conduct technology planning, software evaluation and selection for the Java – Websphere AIX production and Windows Websphere development environment;
- Develop and document large scale application and component architectures for both internal and external facing systems (Intranet, WEB) in line with existing architectural principles as they apply to Java development;
- Conduct integration of Java component operations with supporting mainframe component operations, and C++ Windows applications;
- Work with the lead application architect to ensure Java applications and components are developed in a consistent manner with architectural principles;
- Develop strategies and plan related to the use of Java for Web-based and non-Web-based applications;
- Provide technical leadership and mentoring to the project team in the design and development of Java applications and components;
- Design, develop, document and test Java applications, components and Web Services, both directly and in support of the project team; and
- Implement principles and procedures in support of developed strategies and plans
