1. ORGANIZATION

Business Solutions Branch (BSB) is responsible for the development of solutions and applications as well as the maintenance of existing systems to support Industry Canada business units.

Services are delivered through four organizational directorates

- Business Solutions
- Enterprise Solutions
- IT Modernization
- SITT & CIPO Development and Support

The Applications Maintenance Directorate (AMD) is responsible for the following:

- Support of existing systems
- CIPO specific middleware
- CIPO mainframe database and data administration

This requirement will fall under the support of existing systems which includes the following:

- Responsible for the maintenances and upkeep of business unit specific existing applications;
- Works closely with the business units to understand their needs and technical requirements;
- Manages dispensation of sun-setting application and/or technologies; and
- Works closely with the development teams building replacement systems in order to ensure proper migration of data, effective integration and compatibility with the existing system during the release and roll-out.

2. PROJECT OVERVIEW - CIPO IT IMPLEMENTATION OF A PATENT INTERNATIONAL TREATY (PLT):

Wide reaching changes are required to the main Patent system as the PLT harmonizes the rules and processing of patent applications among member countries. The major areas of change concern the minimum application requirements which can be requested at the time of filing to establish a filing date.

Currently, applicants cannot secure a filing date without paying a fee; under the PLT, the fee will no longer be required for the purpose of securing a filing date. In addition, the PLT makes it possible for the applicant, not just a patent agent, to pay the maintenance fees for both applications and patents. System changes are not only required at the step of the original filing but also at later steps impacting other areas of the patent processing system.

Tasks are centered on the maintenance and support of applications based on specifications and requirements according to IC's standards and guidelines and legislative requirements.

3. SCOPE OF WORK / KEY ACTIVITIES

There is a need for a Systems Analyst level - 2 to assist the maintenance team with the ongoing maintenance and support of patent law treaty applications. This resource will work directly with the applications maintenance team providing expertise in CA Gen and TechSource maintenance and support.

Duties may include:

- Work in compliance with the programming and documentation standards and best practices as established by Industry Canada;
- Provide high quality customer service support throughout the length of the contract;
- Collaborate with all members of the team to implement CA Gen and TechSource applications to meet the client needs;
- Develop technical estimates, specifications and documentation for assigned workload as required;
- Maintain and generate CA Gen program code as required;
- Coordinate multiple, parallel projects and the CA Gen models;
- Manage CA Gen models and CA Gen model families in the mainframe MVS CE operating environment;
- Analyze CA:Gen models to determine alignment and synchronization;
- Upgrade CA Gen modules or apply patch/bundle releases;
- Maintain multiple development and staging CICS environments;
