This amendment is raised to answer questions

Q1 Do you have some additional information on how you want this Erosion Control Plane to be done? A1 The type and manner of erosion sediment control is to be proposed by the Contractor. The Contractor will prepare a short Environmental Protection Plan (EEP) for approval by Parks Canada which outlines how the Contractor intends to control sedimentation during the project. The main intent of erosion sediment control on this project is to eliminate sediment getting into the Bow River.

Q2 Do you require the trees which need to be removed to be replaced with new ones?

A2 Trees identified for removal on the drawings do not need to be replaced. Tree that are removed over and above those identified on the drawings, or trees damaged by the Contractor will be required to be replaced.

Q3 Seed mixture you require does it need to be exact? Can any substitutions to specified seed mixture be made?

A3 Substitute seed mixtures can be accepted so long as there is no non-native seeds in the mixture. Substitute seed mixtures should be submitted by the Contractor for approval by Parks Canada.

Q4 Are there penalties for delays beyond the June 26, 2015 completion date if, due to some extreme circumstances, the project needs to extend?

A4 There are no penalties or bonuses specified for this project. There are General Conditions and clauses related to GC6 Delays and Changes in the Work and GC7 Default, Suspension or Termination of Contract.

Q5 Any trees that need to be cleared, do the stumps/brush get hauled locally or outside of the Parks and the rest get cut into 2' sections for local fire pits?

A5 The trees, stumps, brush can be cut and left within the floor of the local woods as directed by Parks Canada. In the case where there is any hauling of wood, stumps, or brush it will be to Pit 69.

Q6 The 900 willow stakes, where would we be harvesting these from?

A6 The Willow stakes typically should be got from a local nursery. Parks Canada have previously used Bow Point Nursery in Calgary. It seems the most likely scenario that the willow staking will need to be done in the spring/summer of 2016.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
