1. Question

Are there any environmental concerns with the fish and turbidity?

Answer:

Yes, there are stringent environmental requirements set out in the Environmental Procedures specifications, some of which are based on the National Parks Act and the Environmental Assessment.

2. Question

Can you just dowl through the existing North abutment and reuse it?

Answer:

No, the original abutment was designed for a three span timber structure, and does not have sufficient capacity to support the single span 24.8 m steel girder concrete deck replacement superstructure.

3. Question

What is the weight of the girders?

Answer:

Refer to drawing sheet 201 – General Notes for dead loads of all elements.

4. Question

What is the rating of the lower Bailey bridge for South side access?

Answer:

Refer to Work Restrictions – Section 01 14 00 for listing.

5. Question

Can the contractor come up with their own design/build option or alternative design?

Answer:

There are no contractual provisions for a contractor alternative or a design/build procurement.

6. Question

What are the traffic signage requirements?

Answer:

The site is isolated from through vehicular traffic. The contractor will be responsible to ensure road closure signage at the road entrance off of Red Rock Parkway. Parks Canada will provide online area closure notification and trail closure signage in the vicinity of the project to manage pedestrian traffic.

7. Question

Does there need to be a site superintendent and a safety officer or can one person fill both roles?

Answer:

Yes, one person can fill both rolls providing the person is qualified and can manage both roles.

8. Question

What is the approval procedure for tree removal in the event that the contractor must remove trees?

Answer:

Refer to Clearing and Grubbing – Section 31 11 00 for clarification. As discussed, Parks Canada will assess any tree removal for habitat impact; otherwise, will try to accommodate realizing the constraints of the site.
