This amendment is raised to respond to bidder questions.

1. Question

Can Parks confirm if drill and blast is allowed for this project?

Answer:

No blasting will be required or permitted. The cast in place concrete abutments will require 25M dowels drilled into the in-situ rock to provide additional anchorage to the bridge abutments.

2. Question

Can clarification be given to the restriction that may be placed on the contractor for access through the Crandell Mountain Campground; e.g. hours of entry, number of entries allowed in total and during one day, days during the week permitted to enter (week days only)? Are there any know dates when access through the campground will not be permitted?

Answer:

Access through Crandell Mountain Campground will be considered secondary access. All efforts by Parks will be made to provide the Contractor heavy equipment access through the campground when required and will be reviewed on a case by case basis. When access is granted it will be from 8:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday. Contractor to follow all speed and noise limitations set out by the campground and arrange any flaggers and traffic accommodations if required.

3. Question

Can Park's confirm that the roadwork's other than the free draining material within the confines of the abutment and ballast walls is outside of the scope of this work?

Answer:

Specification 31 23 33 01 – EXCAVATION AND BACKFILL, Section 1.1 clearly defines the scope of excavation, backfill and final grading of the approach roadway.

3.1. Question

If this is the case we are unsure from the drawings if the approach road to both side of the bridge is to be widened? If the approaches are to be widened it would be impossible to complete the works to install the approach guardrails, until after this works has been completed. We suggest that the supply and installation of the approach guardrails be removed from the scope of work for this project and form part of the roadworks contractor's scope of work. Please advise.

Answer:

The footprint of the existing bridge is shown on the general arrangement plan, the replacement bridge centre line aligns with the existing and is 1.6 m wider (0.8 m either side). The roadway approaches are sufficiently wide to incorporate the installation of approach guardrails, typically approach guardrails are installed once the bridge guardrails are installed. Approach guardrail will remain in this contract.

4. Question

Is there specification of what the gradation is for the "free draining granular backfill"?

Answer:

Specification 31 23 33 01 – EXCAVATION AND BACKFILL, Section 1.3 references Alberta Transportation Specifications for Bridge Construction, for excavation and backfill requirements.
