Question 1: For the Montreal location, the solicitation documents indicate that two primary resources are required, should a Bidder submit two separate prices for each of the primary resources?

Answer 1: No, the Bidder is to submit one hourly rate.

Question 2: How many back-up resources do we have to propose per location?

Answer 2: One back-up resource has to be proposed per location.

Question 3: When is the expected start date for the Montreal location?

Answer 3: It is expected, but not guaranteed that the contract will be awarded on or before September 1, 2015. The services will be required no earlier than September 1, 2015.

Question 4: For the Montreal location VAC requires two primary resources. Does the bidder have to indicate how many days a week each resource will be working?

Answer 4: No, this will be determined once the contract is awarded

Question 5: If a proposed resource's OT registration is "non-practicing" for a specific location, will VAC accept this "non-practicing" registration with respect to meeting mandatory evaluation criteria 2? Or does the registration have to indicate "practicing".

Answer 5: The registration must be a practicing registration.

Question 6: Assuming the back up/replacement resource meets the mandatory evaluation criteria. During the contract period, can the back up/replacement resource also be a home assessment Occupational Therapist that provides OT services under another Veterans Affairs Canada contract? If not, why?

Answer 6: All contractors and their resources must comply with the spirit of the Government of Canada policies relating to conflict of interest. It would only be under exceptional circumstances to allow a primary or back up/replacement resource to provide services as an external fee-for-service provider. Each case will be examined on its own merits, including in consideration of the need for additional service providers in a given area. It is prudent to say that fee-for-service status for all new resources whom may have previously held provider status will be re-evaluated, and unless there is a compelling need for those services, then they would not be able to hold two roles.
