Amendment 006 is issued to provide responses for the questions received and update the Standard Instructions, General Conditions and Certifications.

1) At Attachment 1 Questions and Answers

Insert:

Q25 Within the STR there is no information about shipping hours or restrictions. Can CSC clarify the requirements?

A25 Hours for shipping 08:30 to 15:30 hrs Monday to Friday (Closed on Statutory Holidays)

Q26 Is it a requirement to store a Sea Can on site for equipment storage (ie furniture), as well as a waste bin?

A26 The bidder should factor in a Sea Can for storage of equipment. Location to be determined at start-up meeting after award of contract.

The contractor is responsible for removal of waste. A location for a waste bin will be provided if the contractor so desires to remove waste in this fashion.

Q27 As per Section 3.2 point .7 of the document Additional Requirements for the M CCP Console. Can CSC Confirm the requirement of the small rack for the radio equipment is mounted *between 5 cm and 10 cm above the desk surface* ?

A27 Yes.

I have reached out to multiple suppliers and they are all asking the same questions and have echoed that a tile is not just a tile.

A28 We do not want to provide a specific make and model; however, the replacement tiles should be 24" x 24" woodcore with 1/16" high pressure laminate surface tile. The tiles must meet or exceed 1,000 lbs per sq inch concentrated load.

Q29 Can we assume that the S100 software upgrade 6.22 upgrade can be performed at each site prior to the installation to accomodate the need for IP connection to the S100 from other devices to allow the aggregator soft key requirement. Can we also assume that this upgrade would be performed by others and not included in the bid ?

A29 CSC has not identified any software upgrade in the STR.

Q30 Section 3.4 – Network video of the Collins Bay, Dorchester, EIFW, Mission and Donnacona STR an CSC Standard ES/STD-0801.

This standard has not been provided do we disregard this statement?

A30 Disregard the reference in Section 3.4 item b of the tenders to CSC Standard ES/STD-0801. This Standard has been replaced by the "Design Requirements for the Main Control and Communications Post (MCCP) Console for use in Federal Correctional Institutions" document issued as part of Amendment 004.

PART 5 CERTIFICATIONS AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Bidders must provide the required certifications and additional information to be awarded a contract.

The certifications and additional information listed below should be submitted with the bid, but may be submitted afterwards. If any of these required certifications or additional information is not completed and submitted as requested, the Contracting Authority will inform the Bidder of a time frame within which to provide the information. Failure to provide the certifications or the additional information listed below within the time frame provided will render the bid non-responsive.

2.3 Integrity Provisions List of Names

Bidders who are incorporated, including those bidding as a joint venture, must provide a complete list of names of all individuals who are currently directors of the Bidder.

Bidders bidding as sole proprietorship, as well as those bidding as a joint venture, must provide the name of the owner(s).

Bidders bidding as societies, firms or partnerships do not need to provide lists of names.
