QUESTIONS and **ANSWERS**– Resulting from Bidders submitted questions

1. Question from Bidder:

Will it be the responsibility of DFO to ensure access to work areas for a marine derrick? Including moving vessels and floating dock structures prior to the contractor's arrival?

DFO Answer 01:

Upon submission of a request from the awarded Contractor, the Harbour Authority will make all attempts to accommodate the request.

2. Question from Bidder:

How long can we stop access on the dock if we are working on it with equipment?

DFO Answer 02:

The wharf structure can be temporarily shut down to accommodate the necessary works. Contractors are to minimize shut downs as much as possible. Awarded Contractor is to submit a proposed schedule to the Harbour Authority prior to commencing work.

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3. Question from Bidder:

Fall/Winter low tides are at night. Do we have noise restrictions?

DFO Answer 03:

The preferred work hours are from 7am to 7pm week days. DFO SCH will consider proposed alternate hours if submitted with the awarded contractors schedule.

4. Question from Bidder:

There is a very good chance the cast in place concrete will crack with the jacking loads. What do you want to do about that?

DFO Answer 04:

Minor cracks are acceptable and will be the responsibility of the contractor to fill with approved concrete crack filler. Major cracks will not be accepted.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
