Request for Standing Offer # 01C15-16-S004 Plumbing and Heating Service Question and Answer 1

Q1. Clarification Required: In Appendix B under <u>Services Required</u>, items # 1 and # 5 refer to high and low pressure steam, both piping and boilers. These services don't fall under a Journeyman Plumber or Journeyman Sheet Metal's scope.

Would these not fall under a steam fitter's jurisdiction, or require a boiler ticket? In order to comply fully with the standing offer the winning bid would require to be certified in plumbing and sheet metal, they would also have to have a boiler ticket or be a steam fitter. Could you please clarify.

A1. The work relating to this standing offer for numbers 1 and 5 of the "services required" is relating to minor repairs such as replacing valves or pieces of pipe. Therefore a certified journeyman plumber would be able to do the work. There is no work on the boiler system itself; therefore no other certification would be required other than the certification already stated on the mandatory criteria.
