This amendment 002 is raised to clarify the evaluation criteria.
This amendment also responds to questions received from potential Bidders.

Page 24 - Annex C Evaluation Criteria

Delete: The Bidder must propose qualified human resource complement capable of providing the services as detailed in the Statement of Work. In doing so, the Bidder must propose the number of resources required by the Bidder to complete the work described in the Statement of Work. At a minimum, Bidders must propose one (1) named resource for each of the following Categories, who meet the minimum qualifications for that category.

Add: The Bidder must propose qualified human resource complement capable of providing the services as detailed in the Statement of Work. In doing so, the Bidder must propose the number of resources required by the Bidder to complete the work described in the Statement of Work. At a minimum, Bidders must propose named resource(s) for each of the following Categories, who meet the minimum qualifications for that category

Question 6: Annex C – Evaluation Criteria – C1.2 Mandatory Technical Criteria – 2. Resource Requirements: Will someone with decades of negotiation experience, specific to naval procurement at a senior level, be precluded because of lack of university degree?

Answer 6: In all instances of “A university degree obtained from a Canadian university or the equivalent as established by a recognized* Canadian academic credentials assessment service, if obtained outside Canada” Canada will accept “or commensurate experience” with commensurate experience being defined as a minimum of 4 years experience in complex negotiations over and above any other minimum years of experience required to meet the technical criteria. Where commensurate experience is accepted additional points for the commensurate period will not be allocated as 4 years of additional experience.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
