Q1: Will the Contractor have access to the Government Dock at Stokes Bay for use as docking during the contract and on-land storage (i.e. waste bin) of materials prior to transport? If available, what is the charge?

A1: Access to the Government Dock at Stokes Bay cannot be arranged through PWGSC or DFO head offices; however, that is not to say that use of this dock is not permitted if the Contractor can make suitable arrangements with the local facility operators and temporary storage of any waste materials is completed in accordance with applicable legislation. Any related charges are the Contractor's responsibility to confirm and must be included in the bid price.

Q2: Is the awarded contractor required to use Transport Canada licensed and Certified vessel and cruise for transportation of materials, manpower to the Island and waste materials off the island?

A2: Use of commercial vessels, with a certificate of registry (from the Transport Canada Vessel Registration Office), and operated in compliance with the *Canada Shipping Act*, the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* and all applicable regulations, is required.
