Amendment No. 003

This amendment is being raised to 1) incorporate revisions to the following sections of the Request for a Standing Offer: A) Standing Offer Brief, Required Services and B) Submission Requirements and Evaluation (SRE), SRE 3 Submission Requirements and Evaluation; and 2) provide responses to Requests for Clarification.

1) Revisions to the Request for a Standing Offer

A) Revisions to the Standing Offer Brief, Required Services (RS)

i) RS 2.1.7 Construction and Contract Administration, 2. Construction Safety, (b)

Delete: In it's entirety

Insert: (b) The contractor must provide Site Specific Health and Safety Plans in accordance with the contract; this will include emergency response plans, fire plans, etc.

ii) RS 2.1.7 Construction and Contract Administration, 12. As-Built Record Drawings, (d)

Delete: In it's entirety.

Insert: (d) The consultant shall, within eight (8) weeks of issuing the final Certificate of completion, furnish PWGSC with:

- i) a complete set of AutoCAD Project Record Drawings that comply with all the requirements as specified in the PWGSC National CADD Standard, and which additionally include the transcription of all information contained in the As-Built Drawings Set prepared by the Contractor, and
- ii) a complete set of final versions of all Shop Drawings for every Discipline in a PDF format, marked "Accepted" and signed by the Prime Consultant, or the respective Discipline Sub-consultants where applicable.

B) Revision to the Submission Requirement and Evaluation (SRE).**i) 3.2.4 Senior Personnel Expertise and Experience, 2. a)**

Delete: In it's entirety.

Insert: a) submit four (4) c.v.'s of Proponent's senior civil/structural bridge specialist engineers, including three (3) senior movable bridge specialist engineers. Submit two (2) c.v.'s each for senior Mechanical Engineering Movable Bridge Specialists and senior Electrical/Controls Engineering Movable Bridge Specialists. Submit one (1) c.v. each for senior Transportation Engineering, Geotechnical Engineering, Cost Estimating and Survey Specialists. Each curriculum vitae should clearly indicate the years of experience the senior personnel has in the provision of the pertinent services specified in the Required Services (RS) section; and

ii) 3.2.5 Project Personnel Expertise and Experience, 2. a)

Delete: In it's entirety.

Insert: a) for each of civil/structural, mechanical and electrical/controls bridge specialist engineers, submit two (2) c.v.'s of project personnel who will perform the majority of the work resulting from the individual call-ups. Each curriculum vitae should clearly indicate the years of experience the project personnel has in the provision of the services specified in the Required Services (RS) section;

2) Responses to Requests for Clarification

Q 1 Can you clarify the number of resumes for each category the text below appears to ask for multiple copies within each copy of each submission?

What the Proponent should provide: (approximately two (2) pages per senior personnel)

a) submit four (4) copies of c.v.'s of Proponent's senior civil/structural bridge specialist engineers, including three (3) senior movable bridge specialist engineers. Submit two (2) copies of c.v.'s each for senior Mechanical Engineering Movable Bridge Specialists and senior Electrical/Controls Engineering Movable Bridge Specialists. Submit one (1) copy of c.v. each for senior Transportation Engineering, Geotechnical Engineering, Cost Estimating and Survey Specialists. Each curriculum vitae should clearly indicate the years of experience the senior personnel has in the provision of the pertinent services specified in the Required Services (RS) section; and

- b) identify the personnel's years of experience, the number of years with the firm;
and
c) professional accreditation; and
d) accomplishments/achievements/awards.*

I am confused if we are providing 1 original and 4 copies would not each of the 1+4 have only one copy of each CV bound into each submission or would each copy have 4 for the structural and 2 for mechanical etc. Etc.

- R 1** Remove all instances of “copies of” and “copy of” from Submission Requirements and Evaluation (SRE) Sections 3.2.4.2.a) and 3.2.5.2.a).

- Q 2** RS 2.1.6.1 Tender Call requests a digitally signed and sealed drawing suitable for editing. A signed drawing should not be editable. Can this be changed to a signed and sealed version and a separate editable version?

- R 2** RS 2.1.6.1 refers to “a set of drawings”, and not to “a drawing”. This “set” may consist of one signed and sealed digital version plus one editable digital version of each drawing.

Q 3 RS 2.1.7.2 b indicates that the consultant will have the responsibility to “ensure” compliance by the contractor with Safety requirements. We as the consultant cannot and do not control the actions and process of the contractor and thus cannot possibly ensure that the contractor is conforming. At best we can point out areas where we believe that the contractor is not conforming or where danger may exist so that they can review the work. The consultant does not have a contract with the contractor and thus any direction we would give would be at the direction of PWGSC through the terms of this standing offer and thus PWGSC through the consultant would be attempting to direct the contract and would be placed in a position where they could be considered the constructor under provincial legislation and responsible for safety. Could the above clauses be changed from the word ensure to “bring to the attention of the contractor weakness in the plans and potential issues for the assessment of the contractor to take appropriate actions” in both clauses b and c. “Without this modification these clauses contradict RS 2.1.8.2 b which states the consultant shall not “enter into the area of responsibility of the contractor’s superintendent.”

R 3 DELETE within RS 2.1.7.2.(b): “The Consultant is to ensure that these plans are adequate and are adhered to at all times.”

All other terms and conditions of the solicitation remain the same.
