

Q1. On Pg #21 of the tender document it specifies that at Bath Institution a 12 cu yd lugger is the bin type and size requirement. Would a regular roll off of equivalent size be acceptable at this location?

A1 We have our bin located under a dust collection silo so it must be able to fit under there. Also this bin will be filled with sawdust so it must be able to be enclosed so that it doesn't blow out all over yard while it is onsite as well as blow all over the road during transportation.

As long as it is able to meet these conditions then I am not particular as to the actual type/style of bin

The measurements of the area it needs to fit into are 7 feet wide by 8 feet high and the bin must be able to be loaded 30 inches from the back of the bin overall length does not appear to be an issue as the front of this area is open

Q2. On Pg #21 of the tender document it specifies that at Collins Bay Medium Institution the 20 cu yd bin requires a liner, is a purchased plastic liner supplied per bin drop off sufficient for this requirement?

A2. Yes, it is sufficient.

Q3. Are the bins on the outside of the prison or outside of the fenced walls and which locations (if any) require travelling through the sally port to gain access?

A3. For Joyceville minimum the bins are located outside the fence so there is no need to use the sally port to gain access. Also, the warehouse location is not at a prison so no sally port. For construction some will be inside the prison and some will be outside it will depend on the work we received from CSC. All other locations will require that you travel through to sally port to gain access to the bins.

Q4. Annex "A" 6. Contractor's Responsibilities – Will the Site Authority accept a faxed or emailed copy of a ticket on the day of pickup? This would be more efficient and cost effective than driving back to the site to deliver a ticket.

A4. Yes faxed or emailed is fine but it must be received.

Q5. Page 21, list of locations and requirements – Warkworth Institution – '24 cubic yards – 3 times a year' – How many bins are required and what material is collected in the bin?

A5. At Warkworth a total of two 30 cu yd bins and one 24 cu yd bin is required. For the 24 cu yd bin the material in it will be sawdust which will only need to be collected 3 times a year.
