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- Q1 How much is the tender deposit percentage for this tender?
- A1 It is 10% of your bid in the form of a certified cheque or bid bond.
- Q2 Will the successful bidder have to put a performance bond? What is the amount of the performance bond (percentage or amount)?
- A2 Yes, you will have to put up a performance bond. If it is certified cheque, it will be 10%. If it is bid bond it is 50% for labour and 50% for materials.
- Q3 Is there a materials bond with this tender?
- A3 Yes, it is 10% for a certified cheque and 50% if in the form of a bid bond.
- Q4 Can the tender deposit be used for the materials bond?
- A4 Yes, if the tender deposit was a certified cheque, however, if it was a bid bond you will need to supply a bid bond in the amount of 50%.
