The reference information provided by the bidder may be verified for completeness and accuracy and to confirm reference satisfaction with the services provided.

Failure by the bidder to provide the required references, or in the event that the references cannot be verified or the services found to be unsatisfactory, will result in the bidder being disqualified and no further consideration will be given to the bid.

If the Bidder submits references in excess of the stated requirement at 3.2 Experience of the Bidder, only the references up to the identified limit will be assessed.

The mandatory information required in the charts that follow must be completed in their entirety for each **Site Location** referenced. If the mandatory information is not provided in the "**Site Location** Chart(s) at bid closing, the proposal will be deemed non-responsive and no further consideration will be given.

The first part is the **Site Location** Chart(s), to identify the contact information for the reference(s).

If the Chart(s) that follow do not allow the Bidder sufficient space to provide the required information, a separate sheet may be attached (identifying the contents of the Site Location Chart) with the bid.

Drummond Ltd., Crete Ryan Construction, Landscape Effects Group, Caltrio Company Ltd, Forestell Designed Landscape

Vallati Paving & Concrete – Frank Zacconi withdrew just before we started to walk around and he was also withdrawing from EJ196-161632 (FUSE)

Munro & Scullion Contracting did not show up

- Introduced myself and the technical authority.

- Reminded the Bidders to Review the SOW as each one is different for each site and there have been revisions

- Advised the bidders that Annex B is now the pricing scheduling and it is to be completely filled out, if no price insert the \$0, if pricing is missing they will be non-responsive

- Reminded the Bidders to complete pricing clearly and legible writing

- Advised the bidders that they need to complete Employee Information List in Part 6 at bid closing
- Reminded all bidders to send in all names of employees to be cleared and to ensure that all names sent had Reliability clearance, explained that if they for example sent in 20 names and one did not have clearance they would be deemed non-responsive.

- Advised bidders to review new Integrity declaration form (Annex I)

- Advised the bidders to disregard any mention of Landscape in RFP such as 3.1.1 Mandatory Full Time Supervisor this is not required for Snow Removal, at 3.2 remove similar size and scope (amendment will follow to remove)

- reviewed with the contractors on how to complete the Reference Chart concerning the years of experience, it should show 3 completed years

- ensure that the month & year is shown -- do not write "since such a year to present"

- The bidders were told that when the TA is reviewing the references they will only try 3 times to contact them so that it does not hold up the process

- Bidders were reminded to ensure that they contact their references to let them know that they will be using them and also ensure that the references have the proper names, telephone

number and email address. They were reminded to make sure the reference name submitted is still with that company or make sure they get the replacement name.

- Reminded the Bidders there is a Financial Security of 20% of firm pricing from the winning contractor
- bidders were reminded to review Part 4 Evaluation of the RFP as this will show them what is required
 - Bidders were reminded that any extra work was only to be done as an amendment or call up from the CA or TA. If they do extra work for someone on the base they will not be paid.

The job showing was then conducted by the TA.

The TA spoke of the following:

- The site is operational 24/7
- Review Clause 4 of the SOW for any additions or deletions to work.
- Review site plan as some areas are not part of this contract. Review Clause 16, Contractor is to respect all demarcation lines being shared with other Contractors on site.
- Stock pile snow as indicated on site plan (2 snow dumps areas are at Hanger 14 and Building 16)
- Reminded them that log sheets are to be completed for invoices to be processed in timely manner.
- Special ops and extra work will be done on an as & when basis as a call-up. There is no guaranty of any additional work.
- Review Clause 6 of the SOW. Catch basins, culverts, fire hydrants and bus stops located in the Self Help Housing area are to be kept cleared.
- Review Clause 7 of the SOW. There a 4 lift stations to be cleared.
- Review Clause 11 of the SOW. Vents around the trailers at Bluenose Compound and 30th Field (Bldg 559) must be kept cleared.
- TA said that upon award of contract the winning bidder will get keys for gates or something will be worked out with the base to get into any locked or fenced areas.
- There are approx 10 garbage receptacles to be cleaned out. Noted that a couple in particular fill up fast due to dog walkers.
- The TA had the bidders take a look at the parking/fenced in area of Bldg 14 which is kept locked at all times and if required to walk through the building they will need to sign in & out.
- Note: As per SOW, Section 2 Clause 3 Site is to be cleared by 7:00AM, 7 days a week

9:55am headed to the Ammo Compound

- TA reminded the bidders that the gates, doorways & garage doors are to be kept cleared at all times.
- CA advised the bidders if anyone wanted to drive around the site as part of the job showing that was fine, but that everyone would have to go along. No one requested a group drive around the site. They were advised they were free to drive around the site with the site plan to have a closer look at what is required and to forward any questions in writing to you in writing to the CA (Cris Hill) 5 days before closing date.
