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## QUESTION AND ANSWER

Question #22 The designated substance reports identified asbestos, lead and mercury as being present in the comfort stations. The specifications contained sections dealing with removal of the asbestos and the mercury but not the lead paint. Is the lead content of the paint considered safe for disposal at a regular landfill? If not will you be issuing directions for removal and disposal of the lead paint?

Answer #22 Whole building demolition debris is not likely to exceed the toxicity characteristic standard for lead if it is handled as a single, whole waste stream and disposed of all together. The demolition contractor must determine whether the debris fails, or is likely to fail, the toxicity characteristic for lead. Refer to ASTM E1908 - 10 for the toxicity characteristic leaching procedure (TCLP) requirements. This procedure describes a method for selecting samples of building components coated with lead-containing paint applications. The samples are collected from the debris waste stream created during demolition and are subsequently analyzed in the laboratory for lead. Hence, the lead-containing paint applications in the buildings DO NOT need to be removed prior to and during the demolition of the buildings. In addition, Contractors have a responsibility under Section 25 of the Ontario Occupational Health and Safety Act to take necessary precautions for the protection of the worker. For this project, contractors should refer to the Ministry of Labour Guideline Lead on Construction Projects.
