This Amendment 009 provides answers to additional questions raised a potential bidders as of October 2nd, 2015 (Section 1).

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE RFP REMAIN UNCHANGED.

AMENDMENT 009 – SECTION 1: ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED

- 60. In the event that our company may become involved in a corporate reorganization which would result in the transfer of most of our activities into its Parent Company's business:**

In order to comply with article 5, subsection 8, of 2003 - Standard Instructions - Goods or Services - Competitive Requirements and/or to 2040 – General Conditions – Research and Development, Subsection 38 “Assignment”, could Canada advise as to what further steps are required to inform the Canadian Government of such potential situation?

Answer: If such situation is to materialize, the bidder is required to send a written and detailed notification of such event to the PWGSC Contracting Authority as soon as possible. In accordance with Section 5, paragraph 8 of the 2003 Standard Instructions, “A bid cannot be assigned or transferred in whole or in part”. If a contract is in place and the contractor undergoes a corporate reorganization, the contractor must provide a written and detailed notification of such event to the PWGSC Contracting Authority as soon as possible. PWGSC will assess whether an assignment or if any other action is required. Section 38 of the General Conditions 2040 provides that: “The Contractor must not assign the Contract without first obtaining the written consent of the Contracting Authority. Any assignment made without that consent is void and will have no effect. The assignment will be effective upon execution of an assignment agreement signed by the Parties and the assignee.”

- 61. Employment Equity: In submitting their response to the Bid solicitation and when filling Annex “C”, should Bidders take into consideration their Canadian Subsidiaries, if any, even if such Subsidiaries are NOT involved in the ARS project?**

Answer: No. Annex “C” is to be completed only taking into account the bidder itself, meaning the legal entity that will actually be performing the work under the resulting contract. For the purpose of the Federal Contractors Program (FCP), subsidiaries require a separate Employment Equity Agreement because they are separate legal entities.

62. Would Canada be willing to entertain change requests to certain terms and conditions before contract award should our bid be considered for contract award?

Answer: No, in order to act in all fairness to all bidders, a bid containing requests to change our terms and conditions would be automatically declared non-compliant and rejected.
