Purpose:

A) To respond to questions regarding Call 006.

A) **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Question #19:

4.2 (& 4.5.6) Maximum Standard Component of \$500K - Travel and living expenses are allowable extras. Is that for field assembly and testing?

Answer #19:

Correct, for the Standard Component funding is limited to \$500,000.00 (excluding shipping, travel & living, and applicable taxes). Travel and Living expenses will be reimbursed as per National Joint Council Travel Directive up to the ceiling price identified in the Contract. Travel may be required for Training, Field Assembly, Monitoring, Testing, Technical Support or other reasons approved by the Testing Department and BCIP.

Question #20:

4.3 Price will be negotiated - What if the price we are selling at is already below our cost?

Answer #20:

In accordance with Call 006 Part 5, section 2.4 Step 4 - Contract Negotiations, Bidders must provide price support to substantiate the proposed costs. Price support can be previously paid invoice for same or similar Innovation, complete price breakdown, quotes and invoices from suppliers, published price list, etc. In addition, in accordance with Call 006 Part 3 section 5, the Bidder must also provide a price certification.

Question #21:

4.5 Cost Element for Testing and Evaluating - We are testing our own equipment or participating? Or is this just for service related proposals?

Answer #21:

Each Innovation is unique. In some instances, the supplier may test the Innovation in cooperation with the Testing Department. In other instances, the Testing Department will conduct the testing without the supplier. It is up to each Bidder to include the appropriate costs elements in their financial proposal.

Question #22:

4.5.4 Support Services - This is included in our sale price by phone or email. Would you like an option to have someone present? Would you like that option broken down into training and testing or a lump sum?

Answer #22:

Please reference the online Proposal Submission Form section 8.2(a) and 8.2(b), as well as Call 006 Part 3 section 4.5 which define the Financial Proposal Cost Elements. The cost elements must be entered in the online Proposal Submission Form section 8.2(a) and explained at 8.2(b). Support Services are not the same as Training Costs.

Question #23:

4.5.5 Direct Costs - Materials will be required by the designated testing entity (oil in our case) to perform the actual testing. So are we to supply a cost for this material including diesel fuel to run our unit? Is it part of the \$500k cap?

Answer #23:

In accordance with Call 006 Part 3 section 4.5.5 Direct Costs, if the Testing Department does not have the required material, the supplier will have to provide it. It is recommended to include all material in your financial proposal, understanding that these costs are subject to negotiation. Yes all direct costs are included within the financial limitation.

Question #24:

SC3.4 (b) - For this first unit or subsequent production after test and evaluation?

Answer #24:

In accordance with the online Proposal Submission Form SC3.4(b), it is the total funds required to reach commercialization from the proposed innovation current state of readiness, as of the proposal submission date.

Question #25:

PR8.2 (a&b) - Is this intended to be the same content as SC3.4 (b&c) directly above? Or does it now include an estimate by us on what it will cost the government to do the testing?

Answer #25:

The online Proposal Submission Form PR 8.2 (a&b) is the section the Bidder inputs their financial proposal for the BCIP Call 006. SC3.4 (b&c) is the Bidders estimate of the total funds required to reach commercialization from the proposed innovation current state of readiness; SC3.4 is not part of the financial proposal.
