Further to the above mentioned Invitation to Tender documentation previously posted on the Government Electronic Tendering Site (GETS), BuyandSell.gc.ca, Addendum (#2) is hereby issued.

- Q1) If the gravel that is in the way for the area that is directly adjacent to the C.C.G Building is considered unsuitable, where is it going to be moved or disposed of?
- A1) The gravel was purchased in 2010 with the intention of completing the project in the following year, so It should be suitable for use. If it does need to be moved, we will select a location within DFO property directly adjacent to where the project work is being done.
- Q2) Is there a quantity for the types of gravel that are available on site, if suitable for use?
- A2) Financial records indicate that approximately 2300 cubic metres of type 1 gravel were delivered to Shearwater in 2010, but unknown portions of that were used on other projects. Contractors should base cost estimates on having 500 cubic metres of Type 1 gravel available on site, and give a cost per ton should more or less gravel be required to complete the work as specified.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
