- Q45. BA06 CONSTRUCTION TIME: The Contractor shall perform and **complete the Work within 24 weeks** OR 33 Scheduling. 5 The substantial completion date is set **for 50 calendar days after award of contract**. The awarded contractor is to adhere to this date.
