This amendment is raised to answer questions and make changes as follows:

Q1: Tender calls for 351 Mats; 150 blue and 151 red is there another colour required?

A1: Specification #11 should be: *Color - Quantity – 175 blue
-176 red*

Q2: Must have a density of 290 to 300 kilograms/meter³ inclusive

This does not exist 290-300 is extremely hard and counter productive to the point of having a mat. IJF standard requirement is 230KG is what (they regulate the mat specs for the Olympics). I am sure our factory can make it, but is NOT standard and would be priced accordingly.

A2: These are not standard mats, the mats *must have a density of 290 to 300 kilograms/meter³ inclusive*

Q3: Must be durable to withstand footwear being worn at all times

All mats are recommended for barefoot training. I have outfitted dozens of RCMP and Military defensive tactics rooms where they wear full fatigue and boots and not had issues, however no factory will warranty the product for use against footwear.

A3: This is a requirement of the mats that have been purchased in the past to ensure durability

Q4: Must be puncture resistant covering to withstand the use of batons, wearing of duty belts, etc during various training exercises

No martial arts mat is made to sustain against the use of weapons. It is a vinyl covering over foam; it is simply not possible and does not exist. No factory in the world warranties the mat with the use of weapons.

The materials used to make the mats are made to break falls only and perform martial arts training, not to deflect weapons.

A4: This is a requirement of the mats that have been purchased in the past to ensure durability

Q5: It is recommended the mat texture should be switched from the straw texture to smooth for maintenance reasons and the smooth texture is much easier to clean and will look newer longer. Would smooth texture be acceptable?

A5: Smooth texture is not acceptable.

Q6: Could the RCMP provide a picture of the texture on the mats?

A6: Yes, attached separately
