






Parks Canada's Waterways







Trent-Severn Waterway
















Rideau Canal










Parks Canada's National Asset Review 2012






Parks Canada's Asset Distribution






Deferred Work Distribution






Current Replacement Value & Deferred Work (2012\$)

Waterways Program Funding

- >Approximately \$400 Million Currently Approved
- > Examples of Approved Projects:
 - Bridge Replacement / Rehabilitations
 - o Concrete Rehabilitation Locks, Walls, Dams
 - Dam Reconstruction
 - Lock Masonry Rehabilitation
- > Draft 5-Year Plan to Address Additional Deferred Work

- Defined Accountabilities / Roles and Responsibilities
- Project Management Capacity (PWGSC / PCA)
- Contracting Capacity and Mechanisms
- Private Sector Capacity

- Stakeholder Relations / Communications
- Access to the Assets (Property)
- Integration With Operations





Community Context of Project Delivery

- Parks Canada Waterways assets are also key pieces of community infrastructure
- Projects will elicit interest from diverse audiences:
 - Members of Parliament
 - Mayors and Municipal Council
 - Volunteer Organizations and Interest Groups
 - o Residents
 - Visitors and Seasonal Residents
 - o Boaters
 - o Businesses

PWGSC / Parks Canada Project Delivery

- Potentially \$700 Million of Deferred Work to Address
- Parks Canada's authority for construction contracts is \$10M
- > PWGSC will delivery approx. 70-75% of the program by dollar value
- Number of Projects Approximately 50% PWGSC / 50% PCA
