- Q 2. Harbour Improvements Page 22 section 3.2.3 – The armour rock shall be durable, blasted limestone. Available rock in the area is granite. Granite would satisfy the other requirements listed but it is denser. 30 tonnes of granite will not go as far as 30 tonnes of limestone. Is granite acceptable? Will you be changing the bid quantities?**
- A 2. Replace Specification 31 53 13, Part 3, Section 3.1.2.2.3 with:
Free from cracks, seams and other defects which may impair durability. The Los Angeles abrasion loss determined using ASTM procedures shall not exceed 35%. The armour rock shall be durable, blasted limestone or granite, slate and shale not acceptable.
Quantities on the unit price table are estimates and payment will be made for actual placed rock (whether it is an increase or a decrease from the unit price table).**
- Q 3. Work permit to enter water, is this through you or MNR? Is there a cost?**
- A 3. Fisheries and Oceans Canada will obtain any necessary permits or approvals to undertake the work.**
