Description of the requirement:

The Department of Justice Canada requires services to conduct an evaluation of the Access to Justice in Both Official Languages Initiative that fully meets the requirements of the 2009 Treasury Board *Policy on Evaluation*. This evaluation will assess the Program's relevance, performance and design.

The Contractor must implement the Program's evaluation plan (appended to this RFP as Appendix 1 – Performance Measurement Strategy for the Access to Justice in Both Official Languages Initiative) that identifies appropriate methodologies and approaches that will support the assessment of the core evaluation issues (relevance, performance and design). The evaluation will cover fiscal years 2013-14 to 2015-16; that is, all activities carried out to date under the *Roadmap for Canada's Official Languages 2013-2018*.

Applicable Trade Agreements:

This requirement is subject to the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), Agreement on Internal Trade (AIT), Canada – Chile Free Trade Agreement (CCFTA), Canada-Panama Free Trade Agreement (FTA) and Canada-Colombia Free Trade Agreement (FTA).

Security Requirement Summary:

At the bid closing date, the following security requirement (Security Requirements Check List - SRCL and related clauses) applies and form part of the Contract:

SECURITY REQUIREMENT FOR CANADIAN SUPPLIER:

- 1. The Contractor must, at all times during the performance of the Contract, hold a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS), issued by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).

The period of the Contract is from date of Contract Award to December 31st, 2016 inclusive.

The Contractor grants to Canada the irrevocable option to extend the term of the Contract by up to one (1) additional six(6) months period under the same conditions.
