- 2. Answer questions posed by the vendor community:
- Q1. Can you postpone the submission date by two weeks?
- A1. The Canada Border Services Agency does not have any objection in extending the deadline.
- Q2. Can you tell us the reason why the solicitation posted in July that covered the same mandate, included the services of a nurse to triage and coordinate cases as well as training provided for doctors by the border services, whereas the current one does not cover these elements?
- A2. For effective delivery, it was determined that a nurse is not mandatory to complete medical requirement for removal assessments.
- Q3. For the previous solicitation, you asked for an hourly rate. In this one, you ask for a fixed amount. What is the average time spent on each assessment?
- A3. The amount of time varies from each service provider. The assessments consist of reviewing an existing medical report from the family physician. Therefore it is difficult to determine the length of time required. Please provide your fixed amount based on your existing experience reviewing medical reports.
- Q4. We would like to get the name of the company that currently provides this service?
- A4. The current service provider for this requirement is CALIAN Ltd.
- Q5. Would the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) consider a proposition based on an hourly rate rather than by file given that the time spent on each file can vary significantly?
- A5. No, the Canada Border Services Agency will not consider a proposition based on an hourly rate.

Q6. In your proposal on page 32, Section 10.6 and Annex B to point 1, it seems to have contradictions. You indicate in section 10.6 that the Contractor shall provide a time sheet which must contain the number of hours worked on each case. This is supported by the statement in Appendix B which indicates that the contractor will be paid to "firm lot per hour". Where the contradiction occurs is in the table in Annex B which states that we must provide a "firm unit price".

Please confirm that it is indeed an hourly rate that we must submit. It is impossible to provide a firm unit price, since the time taken for each case can vary significantly.

A6. Section 10.6 within the Annex A – Statement of Work is for the Canada Borders Services Agency to evaluate the time spent per assessments. This data will be used for future analysis.

The contradiction within the Basis of Payment has been resolve through this RFP Amendment. See section 3 below.

As mentioned within question 3 within the section 2 of this RFP amendment; the amount of time varies from each service provider. The assessments consist of reviewing an existing medical report from the family physician. Therefore it is difficult to determine the length of time required. Please provide your fixed amount based on your existing experience reviewing medical reports.

- Q7. Were the medical files generated in Canada or is it possible that the files were generated by a doctor practicing in another country?
- A7. Most medical files are generated by family physicians in Canada but some may come from other countries.
